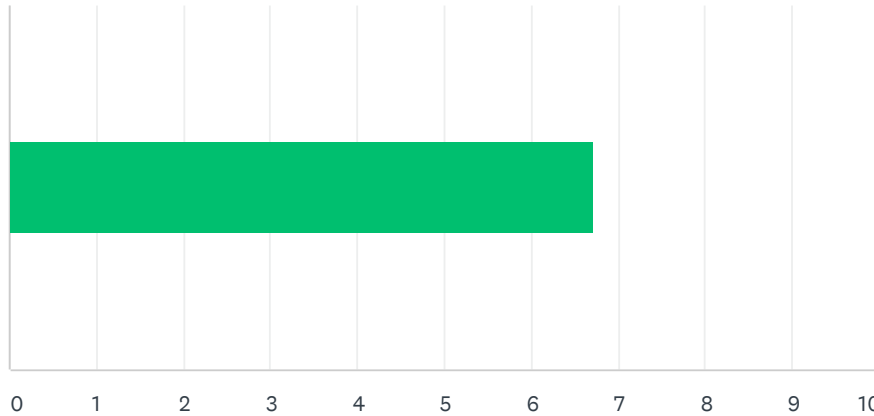


Q1 In the future, I would like to see more housing for senior citizens (e.g. retirement communities; all-care facilities; single-family, owner-occupied accessory apartments)

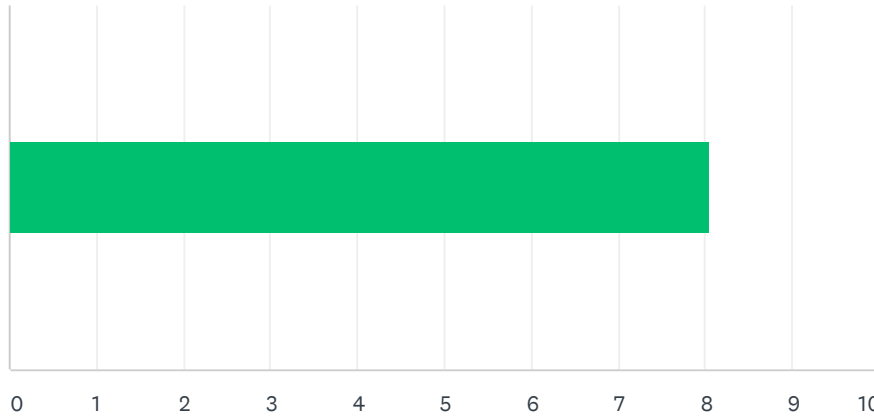

Q2 In the future, I would like to see areas of the Town reserved for low-density single-family and recreational uses, protected open space and farmland?

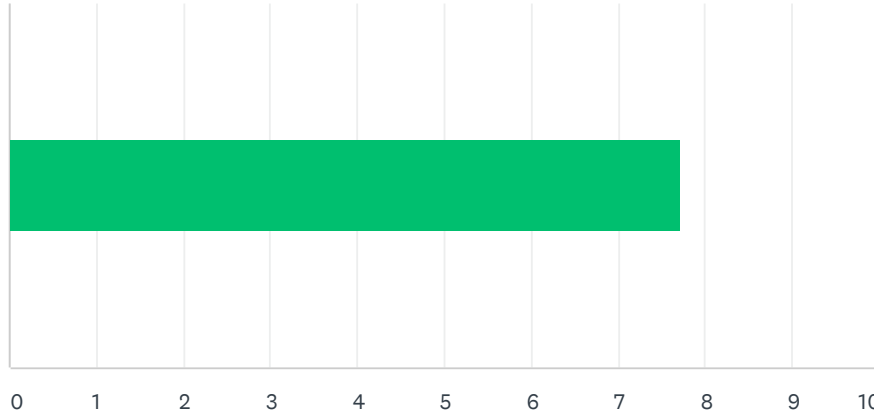

Q3 In the future, would you like to see some areas of the town developed so that offices, shopping, services, recreation, and residential areas are within walking distance of each other?

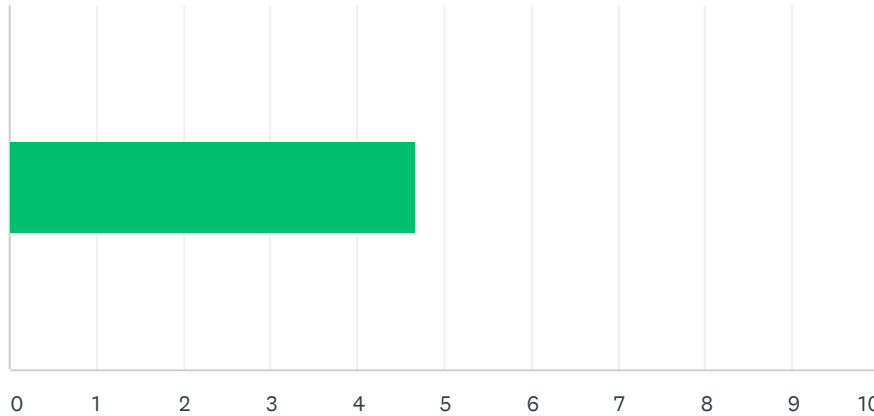

Q4 In the future, do you want to see a balanced mix of housing options that include single-family, duplexes, townhomes, multi-family and apartments?

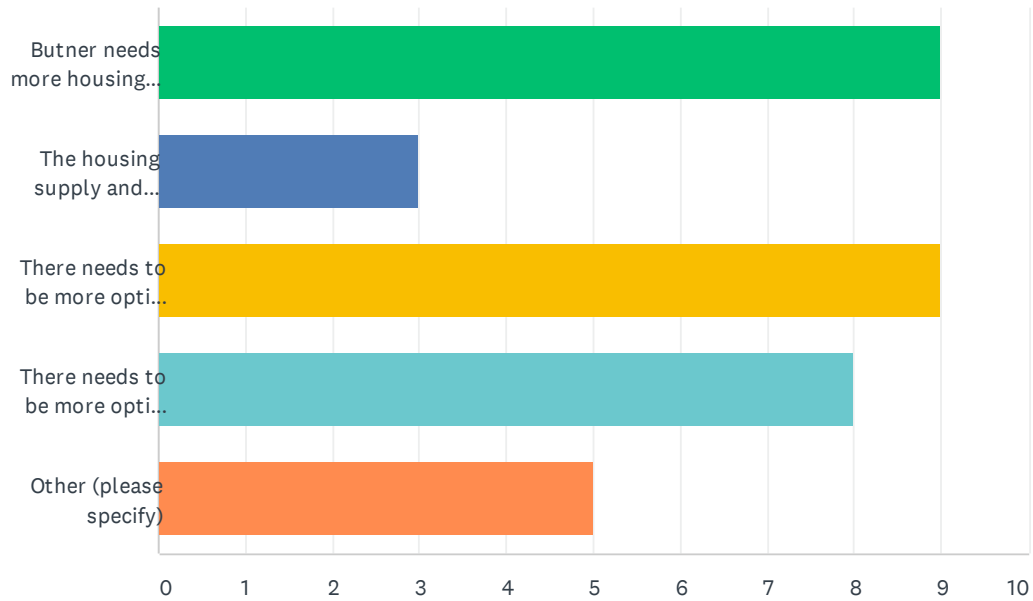

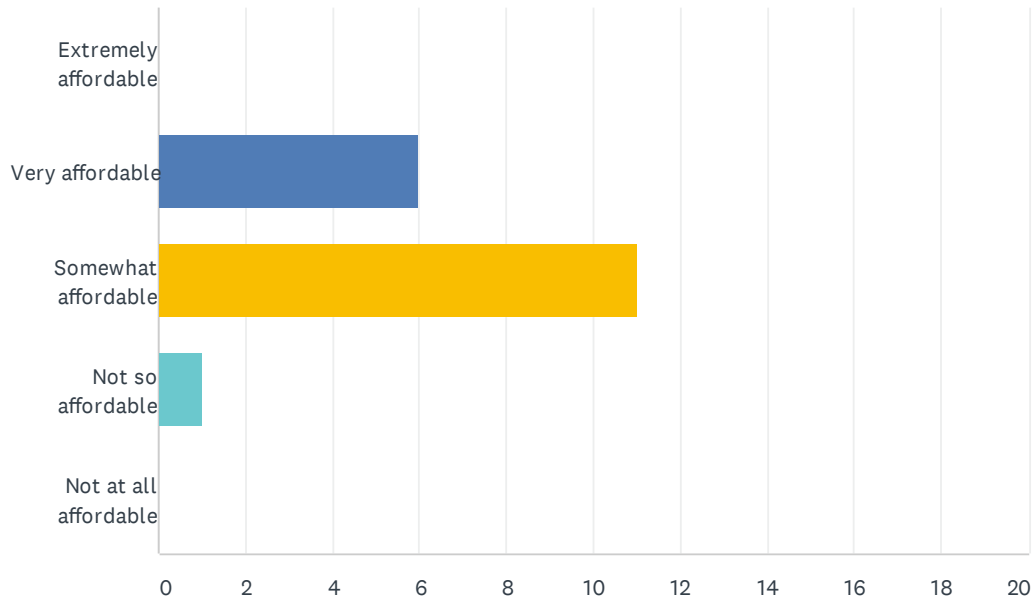

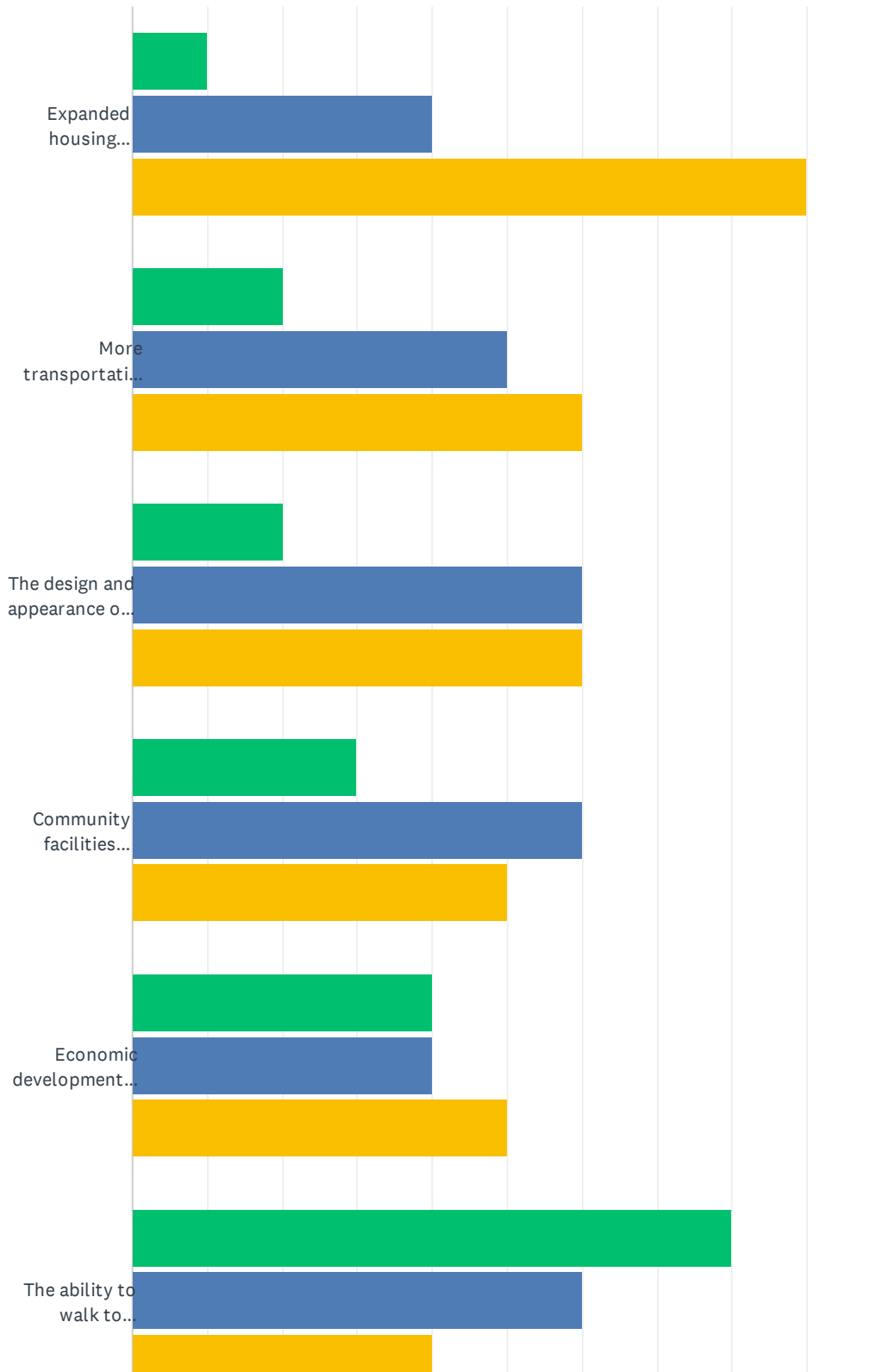

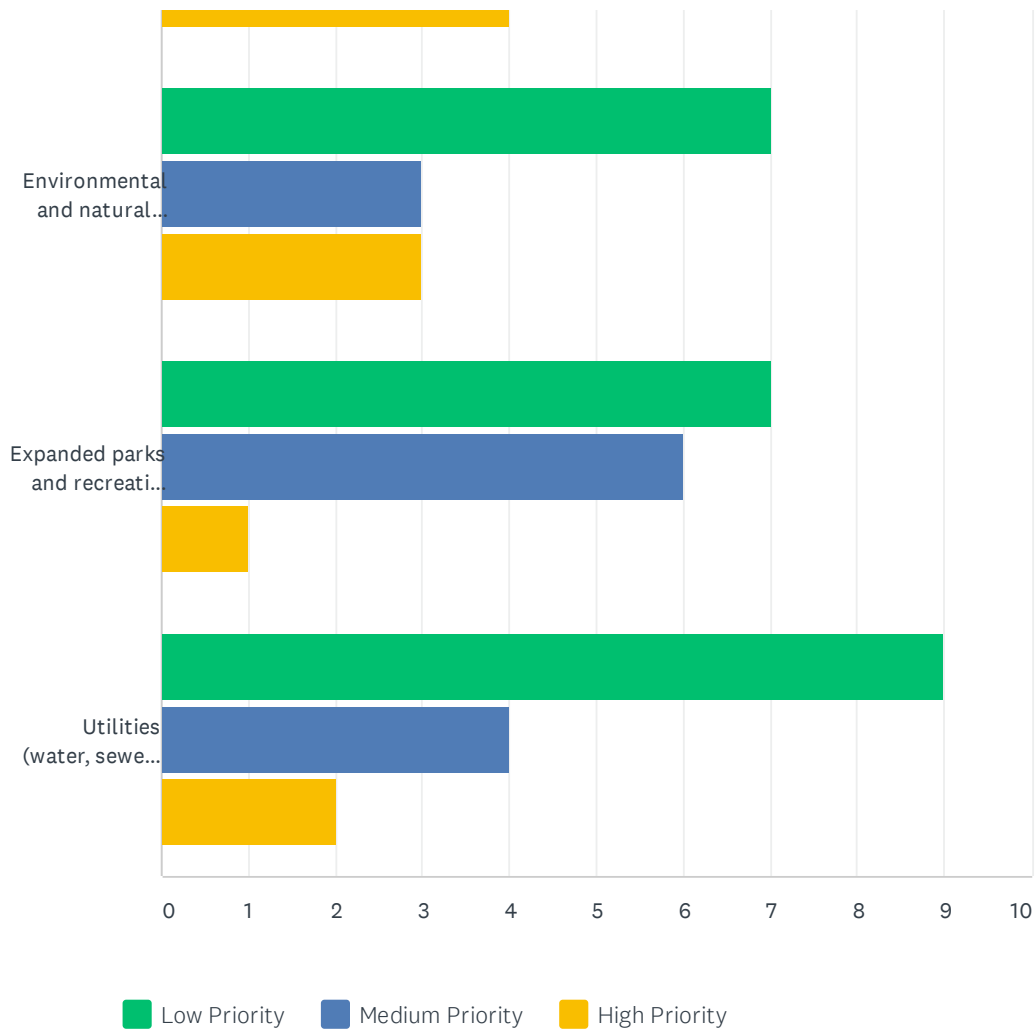

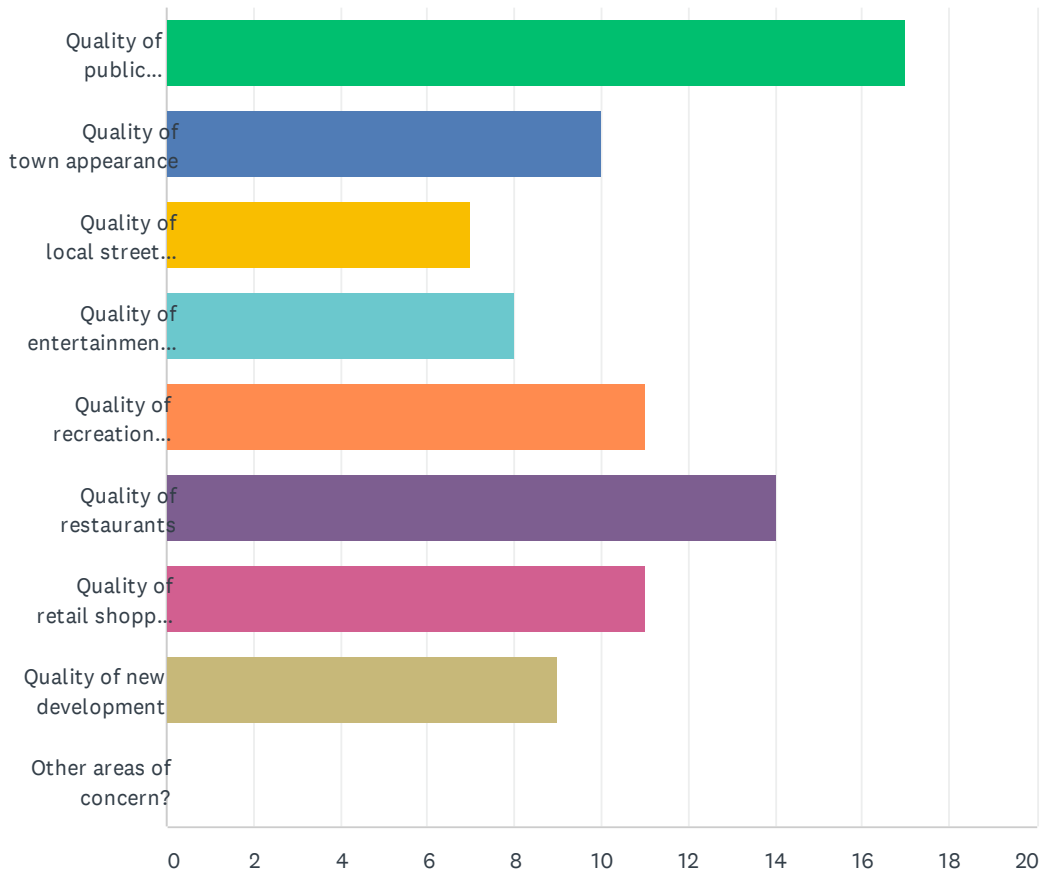

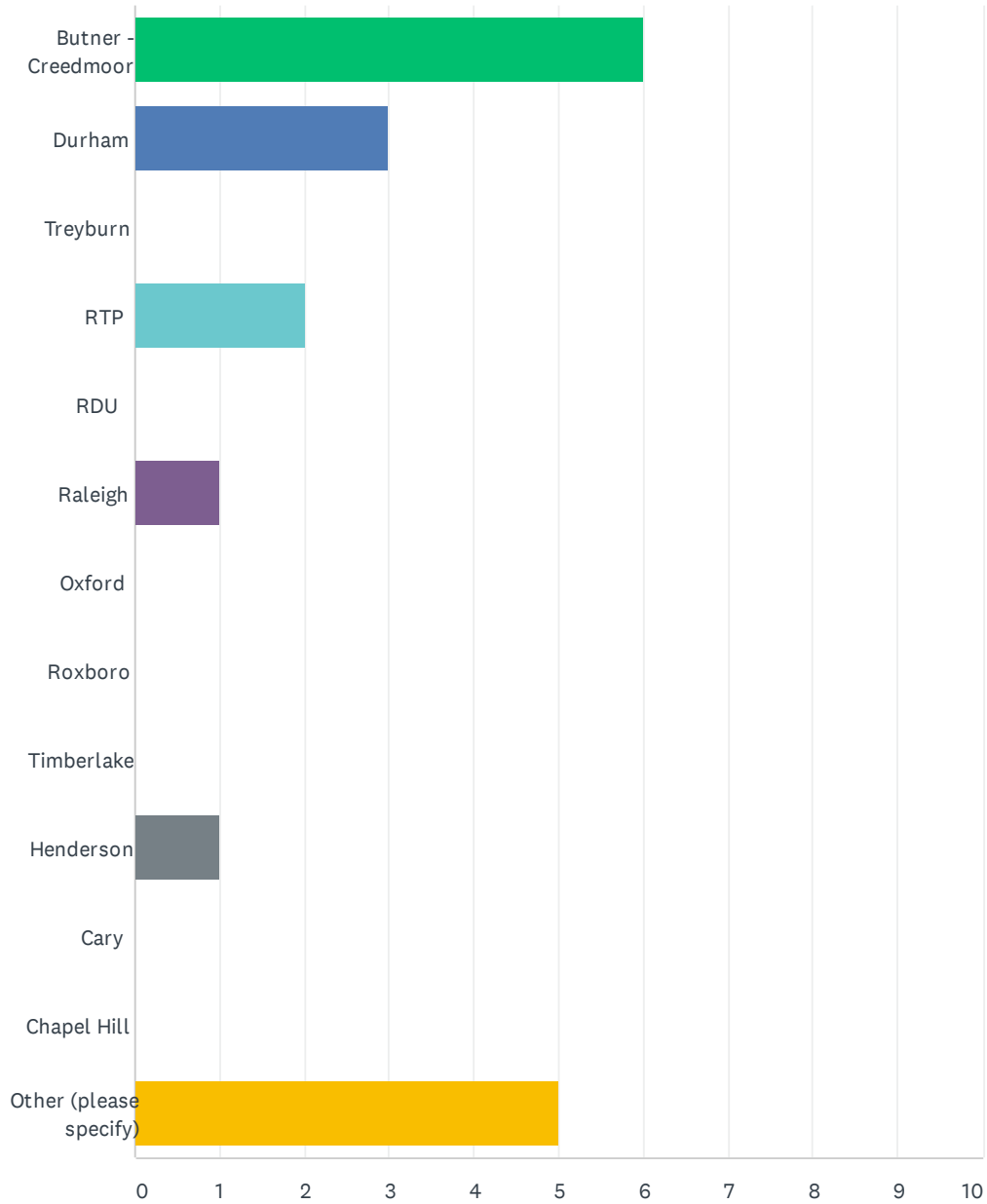

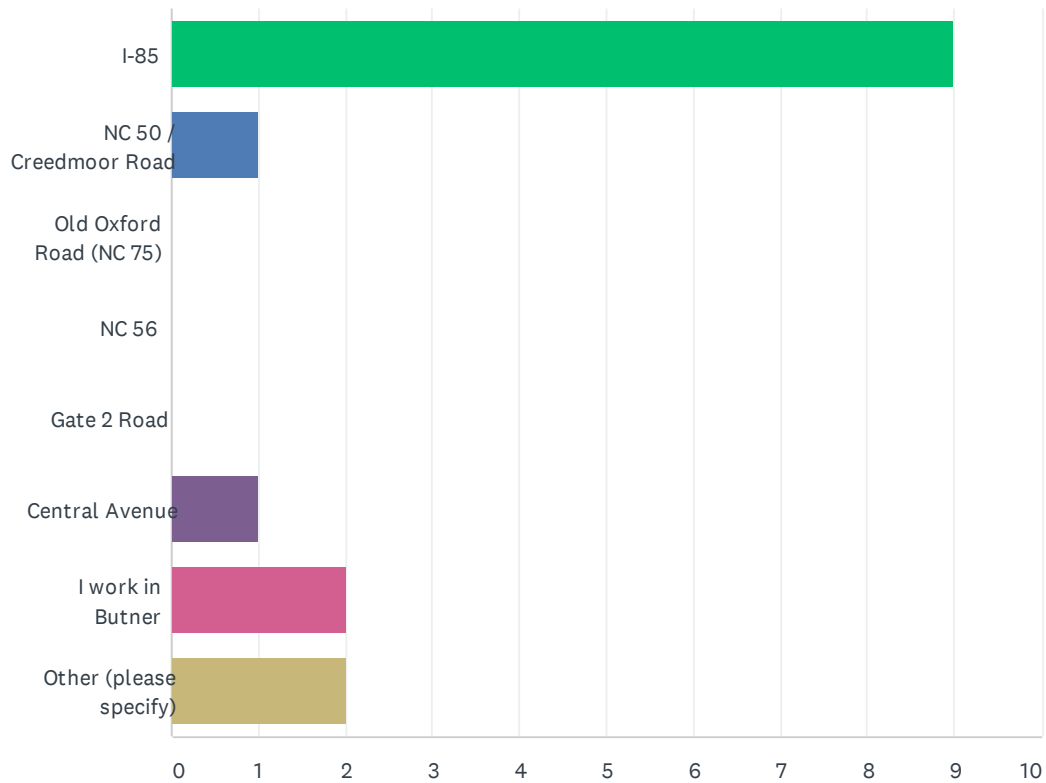

Q13 If you are commuting to jobs outside of Butner, which is your primary route?

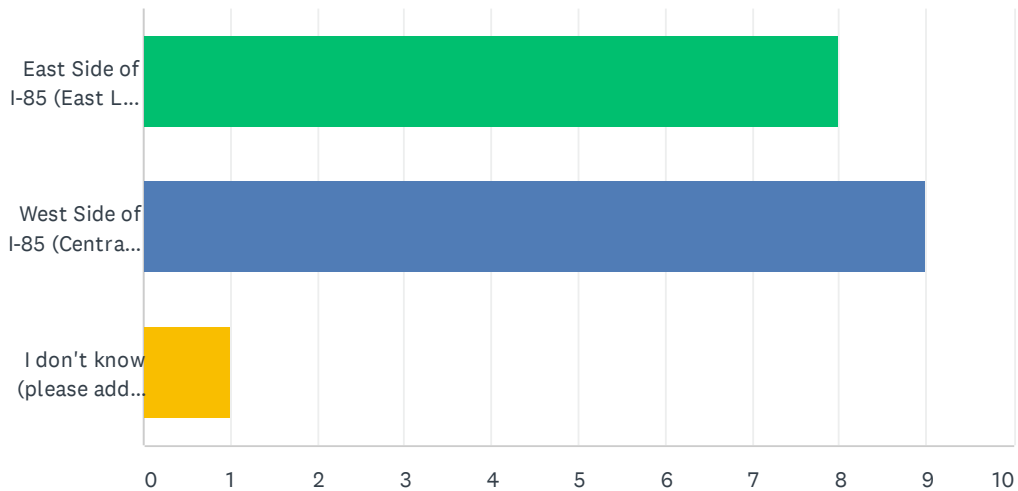

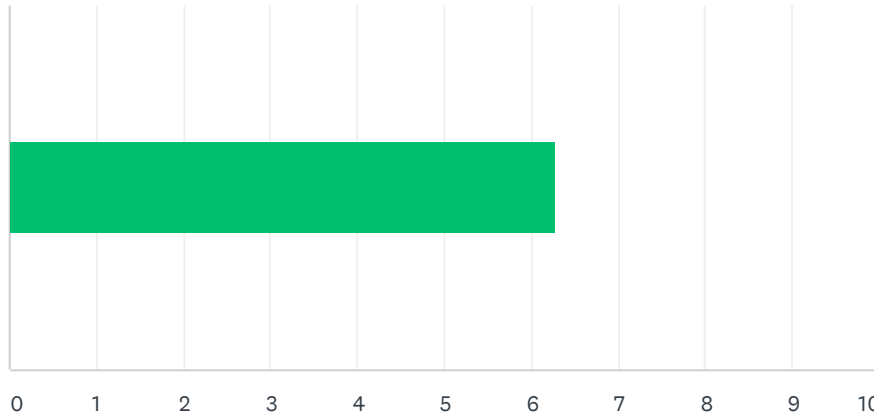

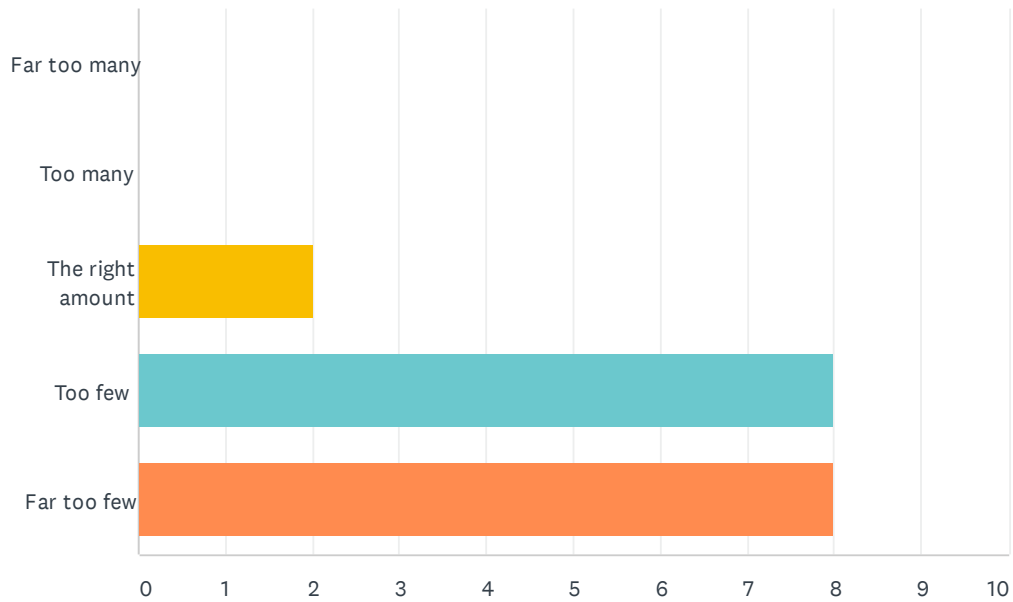

Q16 Does Butner have too many, too few, or about the right number of pedestrian/bicycle paths, greenways, and sidewalks?

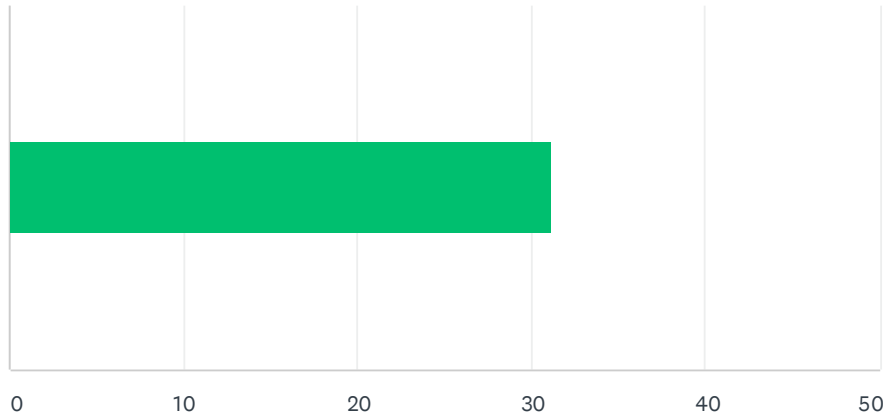

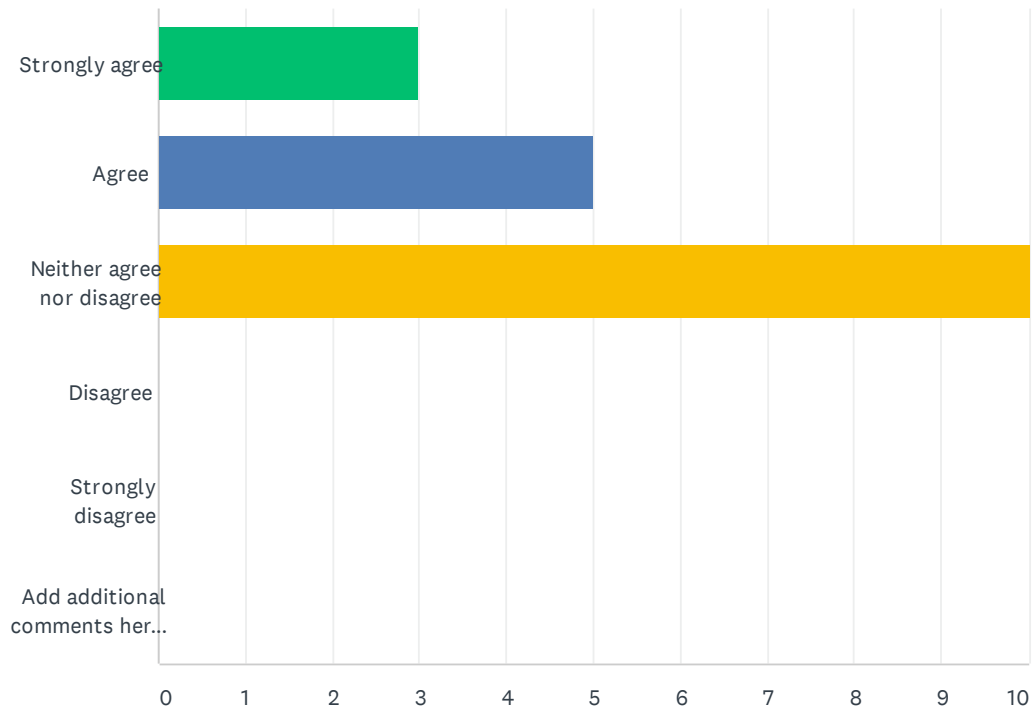

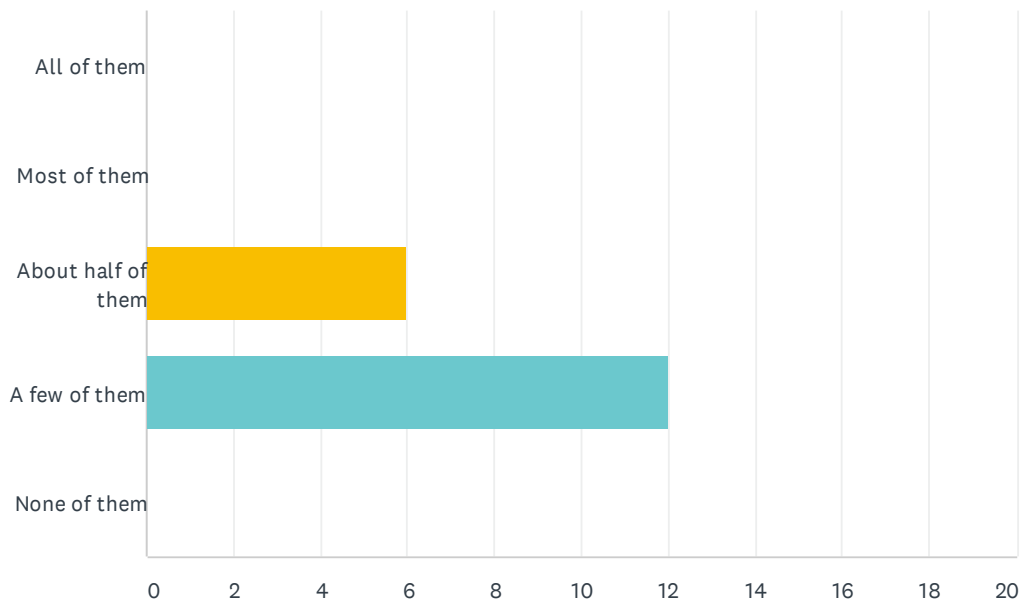
